



CAPABILITY STATEMENT ABOUT US

- We are a passionate local company that specialises in multiple rural services such as pastoralist support, wholesale pet meat supply and biosecurity through large feral herbivore control.
- We have been working in this field for the last 15 years, predominately in the Goldfields and Nullarbor regions of Western Australia.
- We can also offer problematic stock removal services when traditional approaches (trapping, mustering and exporting) are cost prohibitive or unachievable.
- We are highly experienced in travelling and navigating our way throughout the remote, isolated Goldfields' landscape and we have reliable purpose-built vehicles, to conduct these activities.
- We travel with UHF radios, mobile phones and satellite phone messaging units to maintain communication at all times.
- Company employees are licensed Professional Kangaroo shooters with the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions. We have been licensed in this field for the last 15 years. In order to gain this qualification, we are required to obtain a number of competencies including a shooting accuracy test and meat handling accreditations.
- We are members of the Sporting Shooters Association of Australia (SSAA).

- We are associate members with the Goldfields Nullarbor Rangelands Biosecurity Association (GNRBA).

Foster & Co Pet Meat Supply is currently working with pastoralists across the Goldfields- Nullarbor Rangelands, to successfully cull large herbivores and create commercialized value from the carcasses, processed as pet meat and distributed wholesale to the WA market.

Camel harvesting activities have an added benefit of supporting carbon emission mitigation on the rangelands, presenting value to both the environment and agricultural sector.

Removal of large feral animals bares no risk to Aboriginal Cultural Heritage. Controlling Feral or Pest Fauna is exempt from ACH management planning, as it is identified as a Tier 1 Agriculture and Natural Resource Management Activity.
